
Human Body Teaching Project






The Project

- You and your team will become experts on one of five body systems
- You and your team will teach the rest of your classmates about your body system
- Each team will get 2 days to teach their system to the class
- Teams will need to:
 - figure out how to give notes
 - find a lab/activity and run it
 - create a review game
 - write a quiz or Show What You Know



The Systems

- Digestive (processing food)
- Respiratory (breathing)
- Circulatory (blood/heart)
- Excretory (removing wastes)
- Endocrine (hormones)
- Reproductive (Ms. Davis will do this one ©)

 compromise is the only way to include everyone
- Ms. Davis will NOT referee when people are not getting along or can't agree; points will be taken from your work record if she has to deal with your drama
- MOST IMPORTANTLY...trust each other to contribute and do your best

First Steps...What do you need to do today?

- Make sure everyone knows everyone else's name
- Reread the TEACHER FOR THE DAY GUIDELINES so you know what needs to be done
- Each member shares which part of the project they would like to work on
- Make decisions about who will work on which part and with whom
 - Limit the number of people working on a item to 2
 - Try Rock/Paper/Scissors if you can't compromise
