

This is an opportunity for any student who wants to put forth the effort. However, if you earned below a 70% on your test you will be required to complete the corrections and retake the test. Regardless of the category you fall into, there will be an ultimate deadline assigned for retakes/redone work to adhere to—please pay attention to what that deadline is when the work is being handed back to you.

If you would like to earn points back on a test or redo a major assignment please read the instructions below very carefully. Keep in mind, this process should take place as quickly as possible...waiting until the end of the quarter to redo/retake something is unacceptable. You must follow the parameters set forth by the teacher.

Tests/Quizzes: First...for either option is to obtain a <u>parent signature</u> on the test/quiz with grade you wish to replace.

Option 1

- © Corrections must be made for every question missed.
- © Write the correct answer <u>and</u> provide an explanation as to <u>why</u> that answer is correct.
- © Explanations must reflect the material taught and provide examples if applicable; they may not be "because the book/my notes say so".
- © You will then discuss your corrections with the teacher, so we can make sure you now fully grasp the concepts presented to you and understand your original mistake.

Option 2—Pick 1 of the 3 options below (The teacher will quiz you from this before issuing the retake)

- 1. Make an outline from your notes of the main ideas and supporting ideas regarding all the questions you missed and have a friend, parent or sibling test you...OR
- 2. Make flashcards for studying vocabulary or concepts related to the questions you missed and important dates and have a friend, parent or sibling test you...OR
- 3. Make up a new quiz or test using your notes to review the questions you missed and have a friend, parent or sibling test you.

Finally, once you have completed one of the 2 options above, you will then be given the option to either retake the entire test/quiz for full credit or retake only the missed questions for half credit. The test/quiz questions will not be identical to the original ones (which is why the discussion piece of your corrections is so important).

Assignments:

- © If you are disappointed with a grade on an assignment, you can redo the assignment or missing part of the assignment.
- Make sure you take the teachers comments into consideration when redoing your work.
- ⊕ Hand in the old assignment with the redone one (or it will not be re-graded).



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Option 2—Pick 1 of the 3 options below (The teacher will quiz you from this before issuing the retake)
